

## High School Senior Arts Awards

*City of Livermore – Commission for the Arts*

The High School Senior Arts Awards Program is designed to identify, recognize, and encourage talented graduating high school students who reside in Livermore and/or attend a Livermore school. Schools may be public, private, charter or home school, and must be Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) accredited. Winners will receive a \$600 award from the City's Commission for the Arts.

### **Guidelines**

Up to ten \$600 awards will be given to graduating students who excel in their art form in High School.

#### ***Each applicant must:***

- Be a graduating student and in good standing at their school
- Submit a complete award application with a letter of recommendation and official High School transcript by the posted deadline

### **Selection Criteria**

Awards will be granted based on:

- Accomplishments in the Arts at your school
- Letter of Recommendation from your teacher
- Official transcript to verify graduation status
